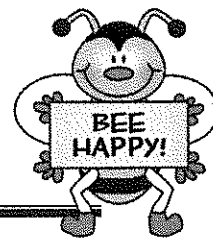

- 10, 20, 30, 40, 50...

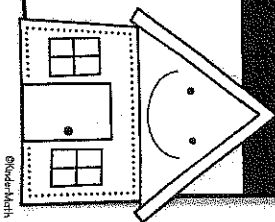
- 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30...

**Unit Vocabulary**

- count: students will be able to state numbers in a sequence up to 100 by 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's
- one's: students will be able to count by 1's to 100
- two's: students will be able to count by 2's to 20
- five's: students will be able to count by five's to 20
- tens: students will be able to count by tens to 100

**Unit Hands-On Fun**

- Have your child practice hop counting by 2's, 5's to 20.
- Have your child practice jump counting by 1's and 10's to 100.

**Vocabulary**

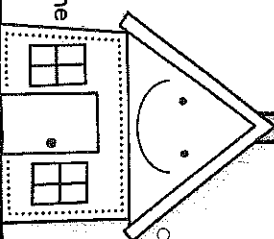
- pled: A number of things on top of each other
