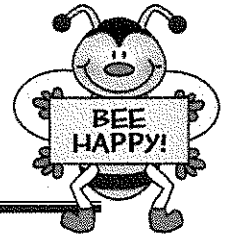

**survey:** to gather information

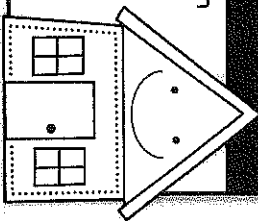
**graph:** a diagram showing how much

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Dear Family,

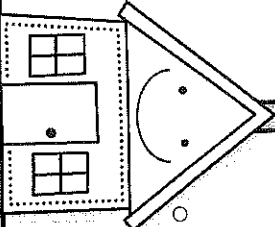

Vocabulary

- **nectar:** A sweet plant juice eaten by monarchs and other insects
- **chrysalis:** An insect between larva and adult stage in a hardened case
- **migration:** Moving from one region or habitat to another
- **instinct:** Behavior that animals are born knowing
- **generation:** The time it takes for a living thing to grow up and reproduce
