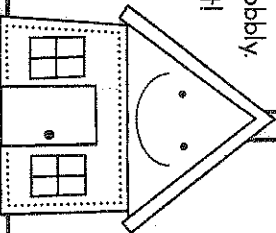
**Vocabulary**

- Make a list of healthy foods to eat and unhealthy foods.

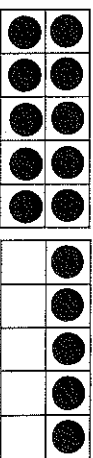
Dear Family,

This unit is all about comparing and combining sets up to 20. Students will also find the difference between two sets.

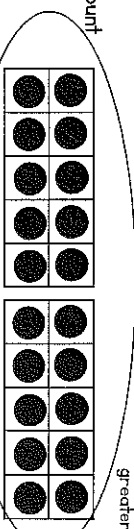


**Unit Vocabulary**
