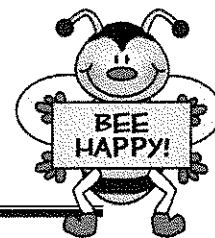
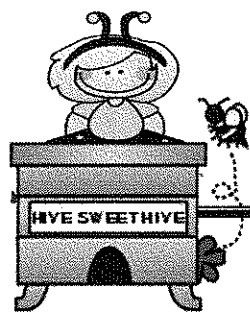

Poem of the Week

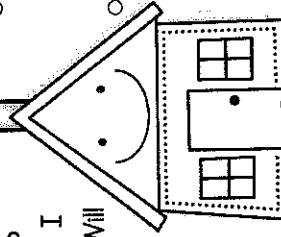
Catch a Leprechaun

combine: students will put

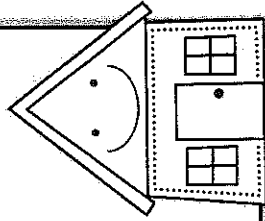
numbers and objects together
