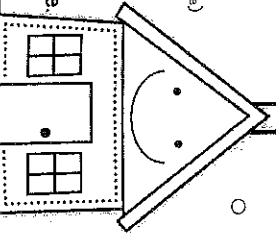
Dear Family,

Could we have a penguin as a pet? Why or why not? We will be informing readers about penguins in our writing.

Vocabulary

- barb: Something pointy and sharp like a hook

- colony: A group of animals that live together
- Equator: An imaginary line halfway between the North and South poles
- webbed: Connected by skin
- marine mammal: Have fur and give birth to live young; spend most of time in ocean

Unit Vocabulary

count: students will be able to state numbers in a sequence up to 100 by 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's

one's: students will be able to count by 1s to 100

two's: students will be able to count by two's to 20

five's: students will be able to count by five's to 20

ten's: students will be able to count by tens to 100

Unit Hands-On Fun

- Have your child practice hop counting by 2's, 5's to 20.
- Have your child practice jump counting by 1's and 10's to 100.
