Plants

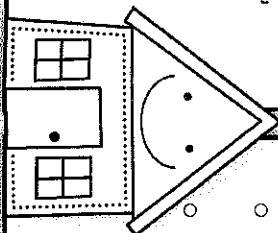
Dear Family,
 Flowers! Who doesn't love flowers? This week is all about plants. How do plants grow? What is the life cycle of a plant? What does a plant need to grow? These are all questions we will answer as we read and discuss Seed to Plant by Kristin Rattini.

Vocabulary

- soil: The top layer of earth, in which plants grow
- seedling: A young plant
- pollination: The moving of pollen from one flower to another. This makes seeds grow.
- germination: The sprouting of a new plant from a seed

Unit Vocabulary

- difference: the result from subtracting one number from another
- subtract: to take one number away from another
- minus: symbol used to take away

Unit Hands-On Fun

- Use objects at home and practice subtracting (taking away). Example: I have 5 pennies. If you take away 2, how many will be left.
- Roll two dice. Take away the smaller number from the higher. What is your difference?
