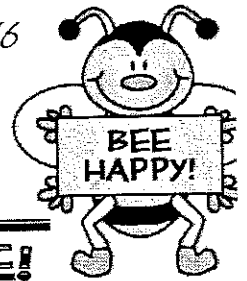

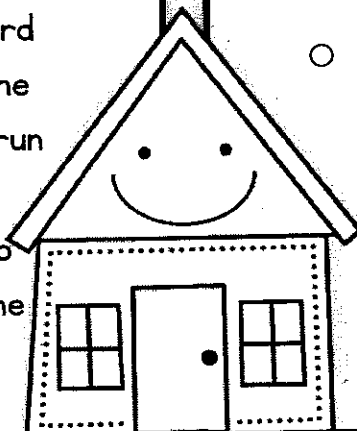
Vocabulary
